Care at Camp

Camp Caribou has an experienced residential medical team. They know our community personally. These are some ways we plan to keep our camp healthy:

- * Pre-camp screening and testing & possible period of pre-camp quarantine
- * Routine wellness checks
- * Frequent hand washing
- * Sanitation stations
- * Masks and staggered rounds of testing
- * Maximize outdoor dining and programming
- * Social distancing and the use of small group cohorts
- * Staff will receive additional training on their role in monitoring the health of themselves and their campers
- * Rapid testing available on-site
- * Optimize ventilation in cabins and indoor facilities
- * 7 miles from the nearest and best local hospital
- * Love, care, and open communication
