- Please go on a creativity scavenger hunt in your home and gather together art-making-stuff, and also collect some recycled items that can be used to build a puppet:
 - Googly eyes
 - Pipe cleaners
 - Craft sticks
 - Painters/masking/clear tape
 - Glue
 - Construction paper
 - Markers
 - Scissors
 - Wooden dowels/Chopsticks
 - Flashlight
 - Thumbtacks/brads
 - Felt
 - Yarn
 - Thin paper plates (white, solid color, etc.)
 - Staples, stapler
 - Several old socks of different sizes
 - Things that you'd find in a recycling bin like:
 - Old fabric scraps
 - Empty egg cartons
 - Old gloves
 - Mesh bags that vegetables come in

- Toilet paper/paper towel rolls
 - Lots of thin cardboard in varying sizes and shapes (old cereal boxes, crackers, etc) - keep boxes whole if possible
- Please have a clean work space that can get a bit messy. A plastic mat or table cloth to work on is suggested to protect furniture and to make clean-up easier.
