## TRANSPORTATION & SWIMMING



### **BUS TRANSPORTATION**

Based on the current guidelines and requirements by state and local health departments, we are confident that we can provide safe bus service with the following modifications. All of our buses will have a reduced capacity this summer.

#### **Bus Counselors**


All buses will have 1-2 counselors on them. The counselors will be trained on our safety and security procedures. All of our counselors will be ready to greet your child and help them get acclimated to the bus and camp.

#### **Buses with Assigned Seating**

Campers will be assigned the same seat on the bus for the entire session. Only siblings and campers from the same pod will be allowed to sit together on the same bench seat. Please see the chart below to further explain our seating policy on the bus.

Our buses will keep the windows open for the entire trip for air flow and circulation. These vehicles have 11 rows and can accommodate up to 60 passengers. This summer we will have no more than 30 campers and 2 counselors per bus. If a child is seated by him or herself, he or she will use the window seat.

## SAMPLE OF BIG AND MINI BUS SEATING POSITIONS



Yellow X indicates a sibling or child in the same group/pod as the camper in the window seat. If neither of these criteria are met, the seat will remain empty.

#### Face Coverings / Masks

The driver and Sprout bus counselor will be required to wear appropriate PPE Campers will be required to wear a face mask while on the bus

#### **Morning Health Screenings**

Prior to boarding the bus campers will be required to complete and submit a daily health screening, as well as have their temperature taken. Campers that do not meet the required health screening qualifications or have a temper of 100.4F or greater will not be allowed on the bus and may not attend camp that day until cleared by the camp health team.

#### **Enhanced Cleaning and Disinfection of Buses**

Each bus will be cleaned and disinfected daily. The bus company will thoroughly clean and disinfect all buses at the end of each week

#### **One Bus Route Per Camper**

Campers will only be able to ride one bus for the entirety of the session. In order to follow best practices and keep our pods and buses as safe as possible, we cannot allow any bus changes in the summer. We will not be able to accommodate playdates, multiple addresses or special pick-ups and drop offs this summer.

#### Parent Pick up and Drop off Safety Procedures

If you would prefer to drive, walk, bike or scoot your camper to camp, please let us know by June 1. Specific instructions will be provided to families prior to the start of camp.

Families will be assigned a staggered pick up and drop off window to minimize traffic at Basis. Caregivers are required to stay outside with social distance to one another and wear a face covering.

Prior to exiting whatever mode of transportation your camper will use, campers will be required to submit a daily health screening, as well as have their temperature taken.

Campers that do not meet the required health screening qualification or have a temperature of 100.4 F or greater will not be allowed to attend camp until cleared by the camp health team.



The Red Hook Pool provides excellent flexibility to safely deliver a swim program. We understand that swimming is a favorite activity for many campers and an important part of our camp experience. Swimming pools have been deemed safe because the COVID -19 virus is not waterborne and pools are properly treated with chlorine.

We are currently planning on providing instructional swim lessons, in accordance with state and local health department guidelines.

Campers and staff will be required to use masks on their way to and from the pool and inside the locker rooms. They will not wear their masks while in the pool.
